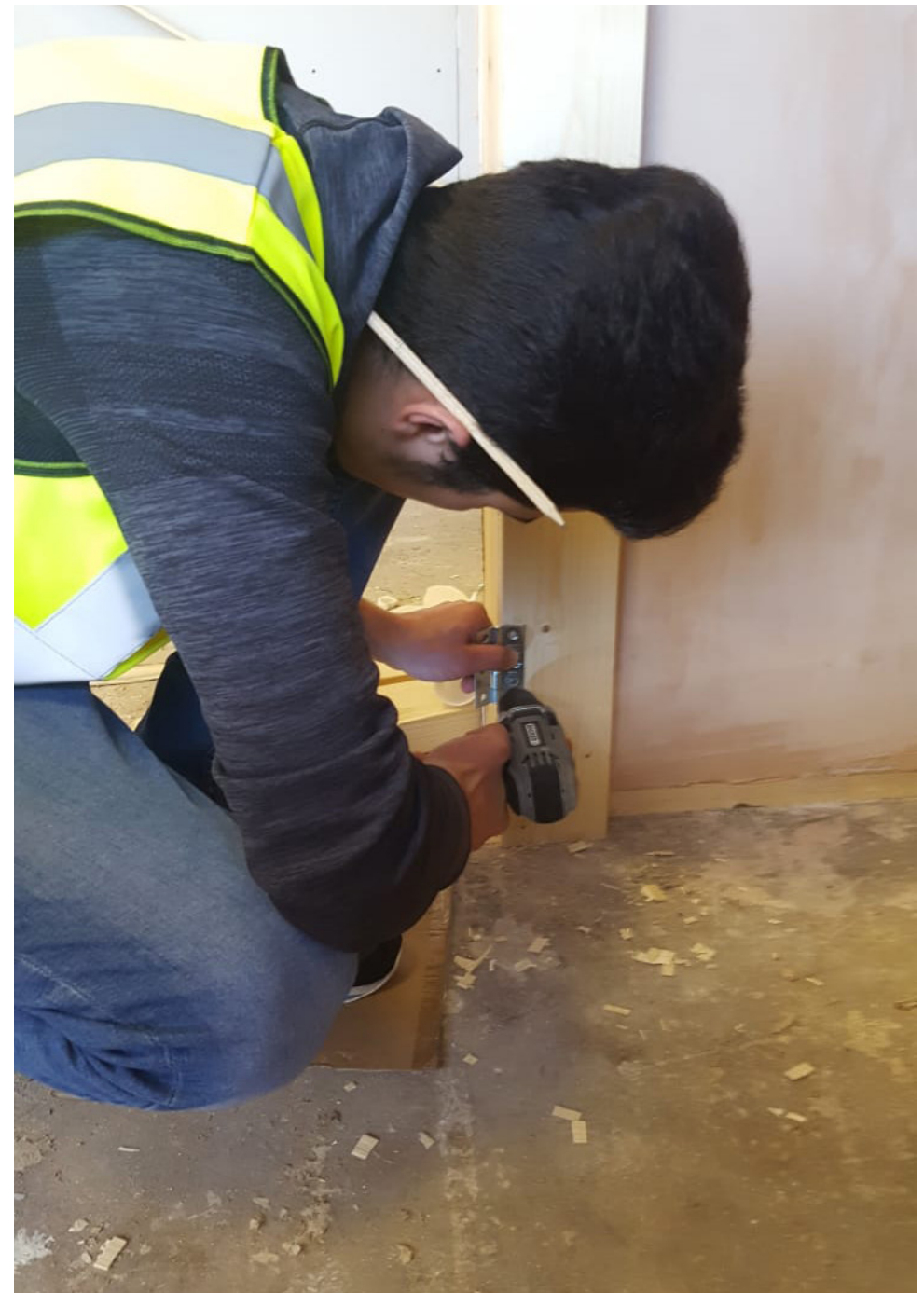

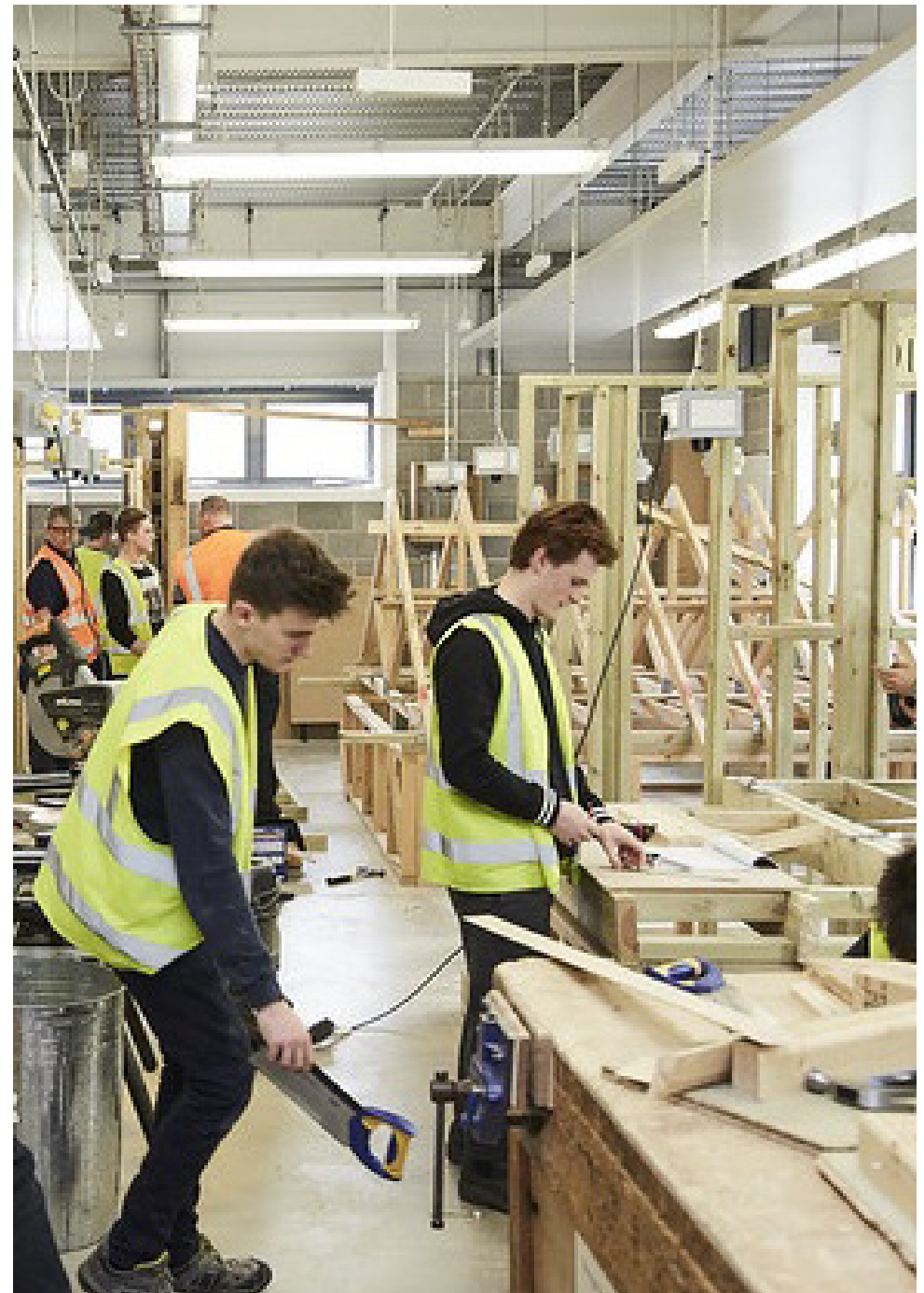
WHAT WILL I LEARN?

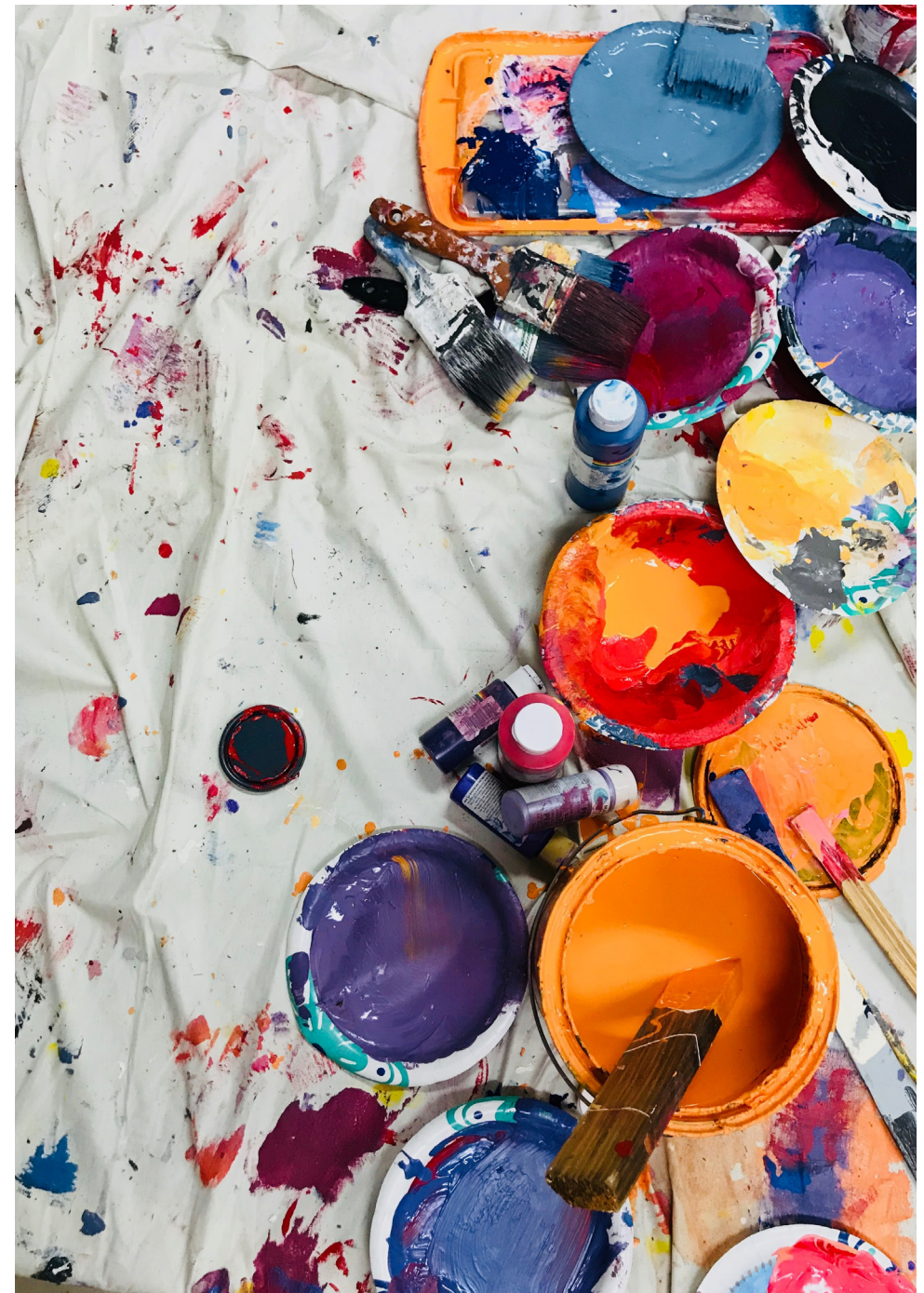
PAINTING & DECORATING LEVEL 1

This qualification is aimed at learners aged 16 and above who work or want to work in the construction industry and specialise in the area of painting and decorating.

Working in the trade could find you decorating brand new buildings or restoring and refurbishing existing properties. Work for a contractor in the domestic, commercial or industrial sector - or start your own business!

This course has been designed to give both practical hands-on skills and an understanding of painting and decorating theory with some health and safety for the construction industry also included.

CARPENTRY & JOINERY LEVEL 1

PLUMBING

COURSE

The course is aimed at people with no previous plumbing experience that would like to gain a recognised UK qualification to start a new career as a plumber.

Courses are split into 2 key areas; Practical (within a training centre), Theory (within a class-room environment). The main objective of this training course is to give you the “hands-on” knowledge and practical skills for your chosen trade, regardless of your current level of ability. This is a uniquely structured blended learning program, delivered by a combination of theory and practical skills acquisition.

The practical training is designed to complement the course, not only bringing into context the theory you have learnt, but also giving you the knowledge, skills and experience you need to work competently and safely in your chosen trade.

ELECTRICIAN COURSE

Each Course are split into 2 key areas; Practical (within a training centre), Theory (within a classroom environment). The course is designed to take you from a complete beginner to a basic electrician, by providing you with a thorough grounding in electrics and electrical principles. It covers a number of NCFE qualification.

The main objective of the training courses is to give you the “hands-on” knowledge and practical skills for your chosen trade, regardless of your current level of ability. This is a uniquely structured blended learning program, delivered by a combination of theory and practical skills acquisition.
